#### **Construction**

Polyester sailboat, type Océanis 440, built in 1991 by the BENETEAU shipyards to designs by architects Bruce Farr and Philippe Briand.

The yacht has been owned for 7 years by its current owners, who are selling it for family and sanitary reasons.
