Full centerboarder, aluminium, 2 rudders, Vulcain Transat type, built in 1989 by Brument shipyard according to the design of Gilbert Caroff-Duflos. Classic type building on ribbands and ribs.

Centerboard lifted by a Lewmar winch near the companion way.

The boat is entirely remade by a professional shipyard in 2010 and estimated in April 2010.
