1991 fiberglass Bertram Caribbean 26' Sport Fishermann built by International Marine, Victoria, Australia, under license from Bertram.

The boat arrived in Polynesia in 1993 and has mainly sailed in the Windward Islands (Tahiti, Moorea, Tetiaroa, Maiao).
